The Journal “Voennyi Sbornik” (2013–2023): Some Results of the Decade

Abstract

The article is devoted to the 10th anniversary of the military historical journal “Voennyi Sbornik”. The research material was articles published from 2013 to 2023. Such research methods as the method of historical content analysis (historiographic/bibliographic method), the historical-typological method and the synthesis method were used in the work.

Over the past 10 years, when the journal was revived again, 138 articles were published in it. The chronological framework of published research covers the period from the XIX to the XXI century. The author analyzes such areas of military history as the navy and army, the Caucasian War, the First World War and the Second World War, the Great Patriotic War, the interwar period, issues of life and functioning of logistics services, the activities of individual branches of the armed forces and much more. The most popular topic was the Second World War and the Great Patriotic War, in second place – research on the problems of the Navy, and often these topics are combined together.

1. Введение

Журнал публикует статьи и сообщения, касающиеся результатов исследований в военно-исторической области на английском и русском языках. На сайте журнала указано, что в своей истории он имеет три этапа:

- С 1858-го по 1917-й год, когда журнал ежемесячно издавался Военным министерством Российской империи в Санкт-Петербурге;

- С 1922-го по 1930-й год: «Военный сборник» выпускался раз в год Обществом любителей военной истории в Белграде;

- С 2013 года по настоящее время. Журнал с 2013-го года выходил ежеквартально, публиковался издательством Researcher в г. Сочи, Россия. С 2017 года периодичность издания стала осуществляться два раза в год. С 2018-го по 2020-й год журнал издавался в Словакии, а с 2021-го года и по настоящее время издается в США.

«Военный сборник» публикует статьи бесплатно; авторские права исследователей сохраняются в полном объеме, однако авторы предоставляют журналу право первого издания материалов, а также право на печатную и цифровую публикацию. Журнал находится в открытом доступе, разрешено пользоваться статьями в образовательных, научных, и других некоммерческих целях, но с обязательным указанием источника при цитировании.

2. Материалы и методы

Материалом для данной рукописи послужили исследования, опубликованные в

журнале «Военный сборник» в период с 2013 по 2023 годы. В 2013–2016 гг. журнал издавался ежеквартально (4 номера в год), однако с 2017 г. периодичность составила 2 номера в год или один раз в полгода.

Методологический комплекс включает в себя такие методы исследования как:

- метод исторического контент-анализа (историографический / библиографический метод): применялся для анализа содержания статей, опубликованных в журнале «Военный сборник» за прошедшие 10 лет.

- историко-типологический метод: применялся для классификации представленных в журнале трудов по тематикам/сферам исследования:

- метод синтеза: применялся для формулирования выводов исследования.

3. Результаты

4. Заключение

В ходе проделанной работы мы можем сделать следующие выводы:

1. За последние 10 лет, когда журнал был возрожден вновь в XXI веке, в нем были опубликованы 138 статей.

2. Хронологические рамки опубликованных исследований охватывают период с XIX по XXI века. Анализируются такие сферы военной истории как военный флот и армия, Кавказская война, Первая мировая и Вторая мировая войны, Великая Отечественная война, межвоенный период, вопросы быта и функционирования тыловых служб, деятельность отдельных родов войск и многое другое.

3. Самой популярной стала тема Второй мировой и Великой Отечественной войн, на втором месте – исследования, посвященные проблемам военно-морского флота, причем зачастую эти темы объединяются воедино. По данным тематикам опубликовано более трети всех исследований в журнале «Военный сборник».

Журнал «Военный сборник» (2013–2023 гг.): некоторые итоги десятилетия

Аннотация. Статья посвящена 10-летнему юбилею военно-исторического журнала «Военный сборник». Материалом исследования послужили статьи, опубликованные за период с 2013 по 2023 годы. В работе применялись такие методы исследования как метод исторического контент-анализа (историографический/библиографический метод), историко-типологический метод и метод синтеза.

За последние 10 лет, когда журнал был возрожден вновь, в нем было опубликовано 138 статей. Хронологические рамки опубликованных исследований охватывают период с XIX по XXI века. Анализируются такие сферы военной истории как военный флот и армия, Кавказская война, Первая мировая и Вторая мировая войны, Великая Отечественная война, межвоенный период, вопросы быта и функционирования тыловых служб, деятельность отдельных родов войск и многое другое. Самой популярной стала тема Второй мировой и Великой Отечественной войн, на втором месте – исследования, посвященные проблемам военно-морского флота, причем зачастую эти темы объединяются воедино.
